

Salve Regina, Mater Misericordiae

Hail [holy] Queen, Mother of mercy.

Salve- Salve means "Hello." Whenever we say "hello" to Jesus or Mary, they come to help us.

Regina- Regina means queen. Mary is Queen of both Heaven and earth. During October we remember that Mary's Immaculate Heart will triumph over all evil in the world.

Mater- Mater means mother. Mary is the queen of Heaven, but she is also our mother! She has great power with God and she wants to help us get to heaven so we can reign with her and Jesus!



WHAT IS IT?

A truly virtuous and holy friendship is one that wills the good of the other above all and encourages the practice of virtue and ultimately friendship with God.

WHAT DO THE SAINTS SAY?

Both Doctors of the Church, St. Basil and St. Gregory were influential Christian teachers of all time. St. Gregory here shares some memories of his friendship with Basil: "The same hope inspired us: the pursuit of learning. This is an ambition

especially subject to envy. Yet between us there was no envy. We seemed to be two bodies with a single spirit. Our single object and ambition was virtue, and a life of hope in the blessings that are to come. We followed the guidance of God's law and spurred each other on to virtue. If it is not too boastful to say, we found in each other a standard and rule for discerning right from wrong."
