PRUDENCE



WHAT IS IT?

WHAT IF YOU HAVE TO DECIDE WHETHER TO DONATE MONEY TO A HOMELESS SHELTER OR TO A SOUP KITCHEN? WHAT IF YOUR FAMILY HAS A TRIP PLANNED, BUT A FRIEND REALLY NEEDS YOU?

HOW CAN I PUT IT INTO PRACTICE?

PRUDENT: *speaking privately to solve a problem*

Plan ahead what to say.
Request a private moment.
Utter a prayer.
Describe the deed.
(Maintain eye contact.)
Effect on me
Nothing. Wait for a response.
Terms

Sample:

P: Mentally go through all the steps
R: You see the person alone in the hall; ask to talk.
U: As you lead them aside, pray, "Help me, Jesus!"
D: "When you poured out my beaker in lab today...
E: ...it really embarrassed me."
N: (Pause until the other person says something.)
T: "Please don't touch my things again or I'll have to report it to the teacher."
